Nancy Olivieri and Brenda Gallie to urge you to ensure that they are able to disclose to patients at The University Health Network (UHN) the harms identified in the progress of their study, approved by UHN Research Ethics Board and published in PLOS One in February 2019 at https://journals.plos.org/plosone/article?id=10.1371/journal.pone.0211942

We agree with Drs. Gallie and Olivieri that is their duty to inform patients whose clinical harms were revealed and exposed as a result of their research, and that UHN has an ethical obligation to allow them to do so, as reflected in Canada's Tri-Council Policy Statement Ethical Conduct for Research Involving Humans: https://ethics.gc.ca/eng/policy-politique tcps2-eptc2 2018.html, The Canadian Medical Protective Association guidelines and policy: https://ethics.gc.ca/eng/policy-politique tcps2-eptc2 2018.html, The Canadian Patient Safety Institute guidelines:
